- Effective supervision should be ensured by Assistant Directors of Agriculture, Anthikkad, Chalakkudy, Chavakkad, Chowannur, Kodakkara, Irinjalakuda, mathilakam, Ollukkara Pazhayannur, Puzhakkal and Wadakkanchery and at Kirshi Bhavan level Agricultural Officers Anthikkad, Chalakkudy, Chavakkad, Orumanayur, Kunnamkulam, Choondal, Nennmanikkara, Irinjalakuda, Mathilakam, Eriyad, Ollukkara, Puthur, Vilvattom, Thrissur, Madakkathra, Vallatholnagar, Avanur and mundathikode. The Assistant Directors of Agriculture Anthikkad, Chalakkudy, Chavakkad, Chowannur, Kodakkara, Irinjalakuda, mathilakam, Ollukkara Pazhayannur, Puzhakkal and Wadakkanchery should release the assistance stage by stage when the project is implemented and the stage war implementation of the project sanctioned.
- b) Seeds and planting materials should be procured from Departmental Farms/Kerala State Seed Development Authority, Thrissur/VFPCK/Kerala Agricultural University/Farmer Seed, etc.
- c) Display Boards should be put up showing the Name of Department, Name of Project, etc.
- d) The whole programme should be documented and CD should be send to Principal Agricultural Officer, Thrissur and separate register maintained.
- e) Launching of programme should be done with public participation.
- f) An agreement should be executed with the institutions, to the effect that vegetable alone will be cultivated in the proposed area for a period of 5 years.

The expenditure in this regard will be debited under the head of account 2401-00-119-85-34(OC) Plan during the current year's budget.

Panampilly Memorial Govt.College, Chalakudy

The NSS family of Panampilly Memorial Government College, Chalakudy is presenting its activities during the academic year 2019-20. Respected Principal Dr. Aravind Krishnan k looked after the activities of the Scheme in the campus. Dr. Jayasre Paul and Sri Sreejith y act as Programme Officers and Kum. Sreelakhshmi K S II BA Political Science and Hilton Mathai II BA Economics act as Volunteer Secretaries. Besides, the activities of the Scheme are over seen by its governing board. For operational convenience, activities of the Scheme are sub-divided into four, each headed by separate student leaders. The major functionaries are:

The clubs are the following:

- i. HARITHA SENA
- ii. **BLUE ARMY**
- RED RIBBON CLUB iii.
- iv. PALLIATIVE CLUB

HARITHASENA

National Service Scheme formed Harithasena, a club exclusively for organic cultivation in this college. The leaders were Vyshnav A A and Vandana Nandakumar. The club decided to start vegetable cultivation inside the college compound. The volunteers decided to cultivate the barren land near the women's hostel inside the college compound. The then principal Dr. V Manikantan Nair gave us permission to clear one acre of land for cultivation during the month of April 2019.

Organic Cultivation: Stage I

Using JCB and tractor, the land was cleared during the middle of month May. Then students planted 55 chena and 3 kg of ginger. During the same month, Vaarams were made for planting organic vegetables.

Fertilization and Pest Removal

To begin with, the soil sample was given Agro Research Station. Chalakudy for testing. From the test, it was evident that the soil is highly acidic and with low content of phosphorus and nitrogen and carbon. Two reduce the acidic character of the soil, green calcium carbonate powder was added. After five days, organic manures such as cow dung, neem cake, bornmeal, neem cake, ground nut cake, marotti nut cake, punna, avanakk nut cake (cafer) were added to soil.

On 15th, June 2019, Principal Dr.V Manikantan Nair inaugurated the function of planting vegetable seeds. Volunteers learned how to plant cowpea seeds.

The volunteers with the help of MGNREGS workers digged 127 pits. Ward Councilor Sri Joy Chamavalappil inaugurated the function of planting bitter gourd and snakegourd seeds in these plants.

NSS conducted many one day camps for adding organic manures and preparing organic pesticides. Veteran organic farmer Sri.Sivaraman Thumbarath gave training in this field. Twice in a week Harithasena members applied organic pesticides such as fish amino acid, chilly-garlic essence pseudomonous liquid, biveria liqid and panchagavya to the seedlings. In every day, volunteers spend 30 to 45 minutes in the vegetable garden. On 3rd August 2019, a panthal was set up for bittergourd and snakegourd. They covered soil with twigs, dry leaves etc. On 18th September 2019, Smt. Jayanthi Praveenkumar chairperson of Chalakudy Municipality inaugurated harvest of vegetables in a function presided by the principal Dr. Aravind Krishnan K. After the formal function, the volunteers sold the vegetables to the natives, teachers and students. In total, the NSS earned Rs.10,000 from vegetable cultivation.

Organic Cultivation: Stage II

After the Onam sales, the Harithasena volunteers planned to start vegetable cultivation in In association with Chalakudy Krishibhavan, the NSS launched Project Based Cultivation in the campus. The Krishibhavan allocated Rs.81,000 towards the college for starting vegetable cultivation for one acre in the college. A part of this amount was used for installing micro drip irrigation for cultivation. By 1st November 2019, drip irrigation was By the third week of October, land was prepared for the second stage of They added green calcium carbonate powder organic manures in the soil. installed. Chalakudy municipal chairperson Smt. Jayanthi Praveenkumar inaugurated the planting of vegetable seeds and volunteers also planted. They planted the seeds of salad cucumbles of bittergourd, watermelon, pumpkin, and cowpea. Every evening the volunteers used to treat the seedlings by adding organic manure and spraying organic pesticides. Some of them engaged in removing the pests from the plants. A few of them engaged in spreading the stems of bittergourd and salad cucumber to panthal. On 30th December 2019, Smt. Jayanthi Praveenkumar chairperson of Chalakudy Municipality inaugurated harvest in a function presided by the principal Dr. Aravind Krishnan K.

Marketing of vegetables

In every alternative days, volunteers open counter for the sale of vegetables at the portico of the college. They sold cucumber, bittergourd, snakegourd, water melon, pumpkin, brinjal etc. Volunteers opened the counter to teachers, students and natives. In Onam season, these vegetables were marketed at Chalakudy town. Teachers in this college well supported sale. They seldom purchase vegetables from other shops.

NSS arranged stall for the sale of vegetables at the All Kerala Organic Farmers Fest at Thrissur on 11th and 12th January 2020. Volunteers distributed vegetables to the inmates at Home for Destitutes at Chalakudy. The second stage of cultivation supplemented an income of Rs.20,000 to the NSS.

BLUE ARMY

National Service Scheme formed Blue Army, a club exclusively for water and soil conservation. It also stands for anti-plastic campaign and implementation of eco-friendly activities in and around the campus. Suhaiba C K (II BA Political Science) and Devadathan K U (II BA Mathematics) were the leaders of this club. The club prepared plan of action during 2019-20. It conducted following programmes in the campus.

1) Discussion forum for Conservation of Chalakudy River

In the light of extreme of pollution of Chalakudy river, volunteers took intiative to invite Sri. Ravi S P, Director of River Resource Centre, Chalakudy to deliver a talk on River Pollution


