About the Journal

étude is a peer-reviewed multi-disciplinary trilingual annual research journal published by the IQAC, Panampilly Memorial Government College, Chalakudy, Kerala. The journal that started in 2015 publishes research articles from various academic fields disseminating knowledge in three languages- English, Malayalam and Hindi. The journal aims to publish and promote research studies fostering scholarly communication and influencing academic discourse.

The articles for the upcoming issue of the journal can be electronically submitted now through the email id: etude@pmgc.ac.in The journal accepts papers on diverse research topics and areas coming under various disciplines encompassing Social Sciences, Physical Sciences, Commerce, Arts and Humanities in the medium of English, Malayalam or Hindi.

The last date for submission is August 30, 2026 and the target window of publication is December 2026.

All research articles should have an abstract of 150 words, with 4 to 5 keywords listed after the abstract. The word limit of the article is 3000 to 3500 words. Use of Times New Roman, size 12, line spacing of 1.5 and indenting of paragraphs are recommended for articles in English. For Malayalam articles Rachana unicode and for Hindi articles Mangal unicode need to be followed. MLA or APA latest style can be followed as per the discipline.

Review Policy

All submitted articles will be subjected to double blind peer review. The editorial board reserves the right to suggest re-submission of articles after revisions suggested by the reviewers/ editorial board.

Submission Guidelines

Only original unpublished articles should be submitted. A statement confirming that the manuscript has been submitted exclusively to *étude*, and is not under consideration for any other publication must be included in the submission email.

Articles may be submitted in the Microsoft Word Doc file format. Official address of the authors, in the order of one to four, or more, should be given on the first page alone, immediately after the title of the article, right aligned. The first author will be considered as the corresponding author, unless otherwise specified.

Plagiarism

All authors should ensure that their submissions are free of anything that may tantamount to plagiarism, in their research article. The research article should be submitted along with a plagiarism report undertaking that their contribution does not exceed 15% of plagiarism. Since the copyright of the submissions rests with the authors, any action in the aftermath of possible and probable plagiarism accusation will be handled by the authors alone.

All authors submitting manuscripts to *étude* are required to comply to internationally accepted standards of academic and research ethics. Authors are encouraged to obtain all relevant ethical clearances, approvals, and permissions from appropriate institutional or regulatory bodies before submitting their manuscript.
